

PUBLIC MEETING SCHEDULED – COUNTY HIGHWAY T (60TH STREET)

A public involvement meeting (PIM) for the proposed reconstruction of County Highway T (60th Street) between Alpine Road and 33rd Avenue has been scheduled for:

This meeting will be held in an open-house format. Representatives from Eau Claire County, Chippewa County, City of Eau Claire, Town of Union, and Town of Wheaton will be in attendance to answer questions, along with staff from Jewell Associates, Inc. who have been retained for the completion of design on this corridor.

A brief presentation summarizing the history of this project, along with the proposed improvement plans will be held at approximately 5:30 pm.

Exhibits and maps will be on display for your review and comment.

This project includes the expansion of County Highway T from a two-lane rural highway to a four-lane divided urban roadway. The intersections of 10th Avenue (County Line Road), 20th Avenue, and 30th Avenue will be improved to meet the forecasted traffic demands on the corridor. A shared-use path is also proposed along the east side of the roadway.

The project is proposed to be split into the following phases for design and construction:

Phase 1: 17th Avenue to 33rd Avenue
Phase 2: Alpine Road to 17th Avenue
